



FRIENDSHIP FLOWER CUTOUT

Materials:

Card stock
Scissors
Glue stick or tape
Crayons or markers



To assemble your Friendship Flower Cutout teaching tool, here are the step-by-step instructions:

1. Print pages 2-3 on card stock. Pages 4-5 have an optional eight-petal flower for older children.
2. Cut out the petals, stem, leaf, and center of the flower.
3. Write the friend's name on the center of the flower
4. Write down words that describe their friend on each flower petal.
5. Use a glue stick to glue the leaf to the stem and the center of the flower to the stem.
6. Then glue each petal to the back of the center of the flower.

To use this teaching tool:

Have your child give their Friendship Flower to their friend to show them how special they are.
