



CLEAN AND UNCLEAN MEATS WHEEL

Materials:

Poster board, cut into a 10- or 12-inch diameter circle
(you can trace around a cake pan or pizza pan for a template)

Black, red and green markers

Ruler

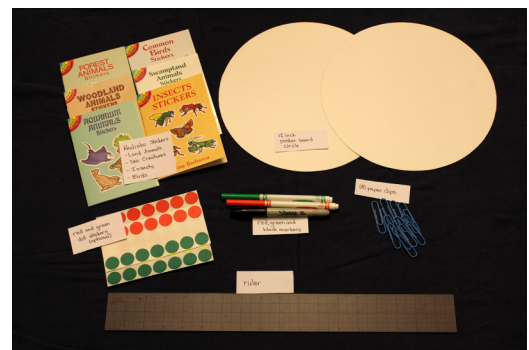
Glue or tape

Red and green circle stickers (optional)

8 paper clips

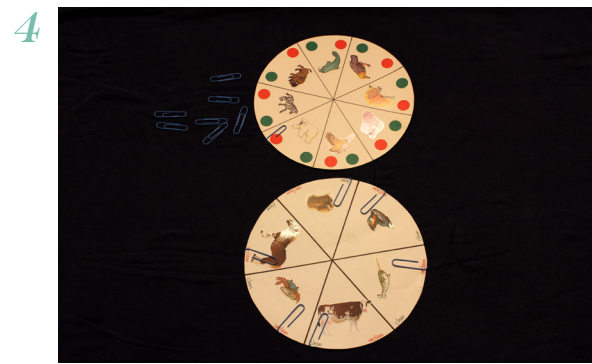
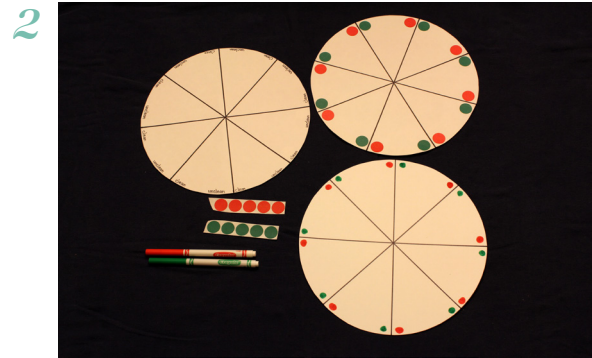
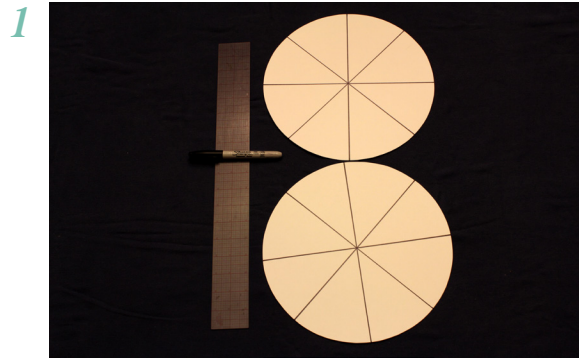
Stickers or photos of:

- land animals
- sea creatures
- birds
- insects



This easy-to-play game is a great way to learn about the foods God designates as clean and unclean. To assemble the wheel, follow these step-by-step instructions:

1. Using a ruler and a black marker, mark off eight pie-shaped wedges on the poster board circle (see photo 1 on page 2).
2. Along the outer rim of the wheel, write “clean” and “unclean” in the corners of each pie-shaped wedge (see photo 2, page 3). You can also use red and green stickers or red and green markers for drawing circles: red means unclean and green means clean.
3. Place one sticker or photo of an animal or insect on each wedge. (See page 4 for additional printouts.)
4. Print off the “Clean and Unclean Meats” banner graphic (page 3) and paste or tape it to the back of the wheel.
5. Make as many wheels as you like!



To play:

Take turns selecting an animal and deciding if it is clean or unclear. Mark your choice with a paper clip.

Once all players have marked their choices, turn to [Leviticus 11](#) or [Deuteronomy 14](#) to check your answers.

Decide on a reward for all the players to enjoy at the end of the game. You might consider traveling to the nearest zoo or aquarium to identify clean and unclear animals! Or try preparing a dinner or a snack of a clean meat that you haven't tasted before.
