White Wine

***Bordeaux and the Loire Valley:** Sauvignon Blanc is the leading variety in both regions, but that's only the start of the story. Bordeaux's winemakers often blend the fuller-bodied Semillon with Sauvignon Blanc and sometimes utilize oak for additional complexity, whereas Loire producers usually make Sauvignon very simply to showcase the strongly mineral signature of their limestone soils. American renditions of Sauvignon tend to show more richness as a result of California's intense sunshine. Chenin Blanc is the other main star of the Loire, making everything from lean, dry wines to lusciously honeyed ones, and the restrained wines of Muscadet are famously fine with bright seafood dishes.*

Burgundy: *Chardonnay's ancestral homeland turns out striking renditions of this great grape in several styles, ranging from the flinty minerality of Chablis...to the softer profile of Mâcon...to the incredibly complex wines from the Côte de Beaune sub-region. American Chardonnays are broader and richer in texture, but increasingly suave as winemaking fashion is shifting away from the very ripe, oaky style of years past. Burgundy's "other" white grape, Aligoté is a perfect aperitif and the traditional base for a Kir cocktail.*

As the climate is a bit warmer, Alsace wines feature a little more richness than their German counterparts, and American renditions are even more generous in body and fruitiness.

Red Wine

***Burgundy:** This region's "Côte d'Or" or "Golden Slope" is a small sliver of vinous magic, a limestone outcropping dotted with tiny vineyard plantings that produce the world's most envied renditions of Pinot Noir. American counterparts from California and Oregon are ever more competitive, however, with more open fruit flavors but comparably soft structure. Burgundy's other global contender is Gamay from the Beaujolais district, which can show a charming juiciness but also achieve impressive complexity and class.*

*The Rhône Valley: Divided into two major parts, the cooler Northern section of the Rhône produces fresh but intensely flavorful Syrahs, while the southern reaches make soft, savory wines blended primarily from Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre. Further west, the **Languedoc-Roussillon** region is gaining fame for producing some of the most delicious, high-value reds in all of France, often from the same grape. These same varieties are increasingly popular in the USA, making wines with deep flavors but supple texture.*

American renditions tend to pack a bit more punch, but Virginia excels in crafting elegant examples.

Bordeaux: *France’s most productive wine region and arguably the world’s most famous, Bordeaux is the traditional homeland of the world’s most widely planted red varieties as well as its most famed estates.*

Artful blending of different grapes results in excellent wines in almost every vintage, despite widely varying weather along the coast of the Atlantic Ocean. Warmer and sunnier conditions in the American

West enables vintners to make unblended versions of Bordeaux’s latest-ripening varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, or to blend to achieve enhanced flavor complexity.
