Biblical Truth: God provides supportive relationships, often when we feel the most alone.

Lesson 27: The Strength to Persevere

Biblical Passage: 2 Timothy 2:1-7

Biblical Truth: Believers have been given the strength to persevere in their faith, regardless of the circumstances they face.

Lesson 28: Encouragement to the Church

Biblical Passage: 2 Timothy 2:14-21

Biblical Truth: Believers' speech can pull people away from God rather than bringing them to God.

Lesson 29: God's Word is Dependable

Biblical Passage: 2 Timothy 3:10-17

Biblical Truth: Believers can depend upon the truth of God's Word when they face persecution.

Lesson 30: Last Words

Biblical Passage: 2 Timothy 4:1-8

Biblical Truth: Believers have the opportunity to provide encouragement and correction to others based on God's Word.

Biblical Passage: Titus 2:1-10

Biblical Truth: God expects us to be self-controlled as we show love to others.

Lesson 32: Grace Has Come

Biblical Passage: Titus 2:11-15

Biblical Truth: Living godly lives gives evidence of the grace of God.

Lesson 33: Do the Right Thing—Forgive

Biblical Passage: Philemon 1, 8-21

Biblical Truth: Believers' faith in Christ cannot be separated from love for others.

Lesson 34: Rejoice in Your Salvation

Biblical Passage: 1 Peter 1:3-12

Biblical Truth: Christ transforms the lives of believers into one that is Christ-filled and set apart for Christ.

Lesson 35: Be Faithful in Conduct

Biblical Passage: 1 Peter 2:1-12, 1 Peter 3:8-12

Biblical Truth: Believers are called to conduct their lives in ways that proclaim the transforming power of Christ.

Lesson 36: Be Faithful When Suffering

Biblical Passage: 1 Peter 3:13-17, 1 Peter 4:12-19

Biblical Truth: Believers should not be surprised when they suffer persecution for their faith in Christ.

Lesson 37: Be Faithful in Building the Church

Biblical Passage: 1 Peter 4:7-11, 5:1-7

Biblical Truth: Every believer can contribute to building up the body of Christ to fulfill its purpose of sharing the gospel throughout the world.

Lesson 38: Be Faithful to Scripture

Biblical Passage: 2 Peter 1:16-21, 2:1-3

Biblical Truth: Scripture calls us to be holy—set apart for God.

Biblical Passage: 2 Peter 3:8-18

Biblical Truth: God delays Jesus' return to allow time for people to repent and turn to Him.

LIVE IN LOVE (1, 2, 3 John and Jude)

Lesson 40: A Light in the Darkness

Biblical Passage: 1 John 1:1-7

Biblical Truth: Believers are called to live in a way that reflects the light of God to those living in darkness.

Lesson 41: The Cure for Deception

Biblical Passage: 1 John 1:8-2:2

Biblical Truth: Since truth and deception cannot exist together, believers must honestly look at their own lives to recognize the sin within us.

Biblical Passage: 1 John 2:3-11

Biblical Truth: Since truth and deception cannot exist together, believers must honestly look at their own lives to recognize the sin within us.

Lesson 43: Love Each Other

Biblical Passage: 1 John 3:11-20, 4:7-12

Biblical Truth: Believers are to love others the way Christ has loved them.

Biblical Passage: 2 John 1-6

Biblical Truth: When we are living in truth and following God, our lives give evidence that we love others.

Lesson 47: Showing Love and Hospitality

Biblical Passage: 3 John 3-8

Biblical Truth: One way believers demonstrate they are followers of Christ is the way they show hospitality to others.

Lesson 48: Showing Mercy

Biblical Passage: Jude 17-23

Biblical Truth: Believers provide a witness to God's love as they show mercy to those who doubt.
