**UNIT 1. SESSION 1** 

## PROPHETS TOLD ABOUT JESUS

### ISAIAH 7:14; 9:6; 11:1-5; MICAH 5:2

Hundreds of years before Jesus was born, the people of Judah had stopped following God's laws. God sent prophets to tell the people God's messages. The prophets warned the people to turn away from their sins and follow God.

Isaiah and Micah were two of these prophets. The message they brought from God was a new message! It was about the One who would come to be the Savior. He would be the Messiah!

Isaiah wrote that the Messiah would be born to a virgin and would be called Immanuel, which means "God with us." Isaiah also wrote that the Messiah would be a ruler. He would be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

The prophet, Isaiah, reminded people that God had promised that the Messiah would be born from the family of King David. Isaiah also said that the Messiah would be wise, just, understanding, and full of God's Spirit.

Another prophet, Micah, told the people that the Messiah would be a ruler and would be born in the town of Bethlehem—the same town where King David was born.

Although the prophets did not use the name of Jesus, we know that Jesus was the Messiah who would be born almost seven hundred years later. God kept the promise He made through the prophets.
