Core Passages: Acts 15:6-11,24-31

### **News Story Summary**

Last September, Chipotle added a queso dip to its menu. However, hordes of customers were disappointed with the addition. Many Chipotle fans said the texture of the dip was too grainy. So based on feedback, Chipotle tweaked its recipe last month. Spokesperson Quinn Kelsey said, “Chipotle’s queso is [now] creamier but still has a really delicious flavor.” Chipotle plans to add Nachos to the menu in the near future. But only after testing in the company test kitchen first.

### **Focus Attention**

To supplement the transition from the Focus Attention idea, read the news story summary. Ask: *What makes adding something to a menu tricky for any company? Does an added item to the menu help or hurt?* Emphasize that the addition of a menu item does not necessarily change the value of a brand. In today’s lesson, Paul makes it clear that adding anything to the gospel would not change its value or power; the gospel is sufficient by itself.

### **Summarize and Challenge**

To supplement the Summarize and Challenge, remind the group of the news article. Explain that most restaurants add and change their menus to keep customers coming. Compare the need for menus to change to the gospel not needing to change. Emphasize that the gospel of Christ perfectly accomplishes the work of salvation for all people without any additions or changes. Ask: *How can we, as believers, keep the gospel pure and available to all?*
