### Call to Worship:

### Assurance of Pardon:

**Leader:** Brothers and Sisters, let us remember this good news: Though our sins were like scarlet, Jesus has washed them white as snow. Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree.” By faith in Christ Jesus, the blessing of God has come to us, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.
