

GIRLS & BOYS BASKETBALL - 6th/7th/8th GRADE RULES -- A TEAMS

Section I Rules for competition: IHSA rules will apply with the following exceptions or variations.

1. 6th grade - 5 minute quarters
7th grade - 5 minute quarters
8th grade - 6 minute quarters
2. Overtime periods will consist of 3 minute periods.
3. All team players in good standing MUST play in each league game.
4. No student/athlete may participate in more than 4 quarters at a given level in one day except during an overtime period or periods which is considered an extension of the 4th quarter.
5. A game will be ruled a forfeit if the delayed team fails to inform its opponents within 15 minutes of game time.
6. Home team shall provide the following:
 - a. Leather game ball.
 - b. Enough practice balls for each team.
 - c. Clock with an official timer – 8th grade or older.
 - d. Official scorebook with a competent scorekeeper – 8th grade or older.
 - e. Sufficient adult help for crowd control.
7. Home team is responsible for recording all scores to the league Commissioner/Secretary.
8. 3 point rule will apply.
9. 6th grade - full court press 4th quarter only.
10. No one is allowed on the court except team players. No shooting before games - halftime - or in between quarters.
11. Game times will be set at 50 minutes. Warm-up time on the clock for the next game is 5 minutes. Halftime shall not exceed 5 minutes.
12. Teams must be at the game ½ hour before a game - No earlier.
13. Time-outs - 3/1 minute and 2/30 second time-out per game. Overtime, teams get an additional one time-out per overtime
14. No press after fifteen point differential.

15. Rosters must be sent to the League Secretary one (1) week prior to the 1st schedule league game.

Section II Member schools agree to adhere to the highest standard of coaching ethics and agree to refute the “win at all cost” philosophy in order to keep the interscholastic program educationally and morally sound.

Section III The Suburban Parochial League shall adhere to the athletic guidelines set up by the Joliet Diocese.

Section IV Conference games will take priority over all other athletic schedules.
