

Shown at the left is a copy of the first commencement program.



There is a definite contrast in the number of pupils to receive diplomas at exercises during the 1960-61 school year. The January and June graduates will total 661. This is evidence of the tremendous growth of the port city. With a population increase of some 15,000 in the last decade, more is to be expected in the coming years.





The city of Lorain had grown, by 1920, to be a thriving city on the banks of Lake Erie. The parade scene above illustrates that progress had indeed come to the "port city." The faithful horse had been relegated to only appearances at festive occasions as this. The automobile begun to make a concerted effort to win favor over the colorful trolley. THE CITY GROWS . . .

A recent photo of the harbor facilities point to the future possibilities of Lorain as major improvements are being studied to better equip the Port of Lorain to receive the ever increasing number of ocean-going vessels as a result of the opening of the St. Lawrence Seaway. The future offers much to Lorain.





Continuing its rapidly changing complex, the city shows the early dependence upon coal. Just a few years later, the switch of the major industry changed to steel. Coal for the world was the cry of the 30's.

Automation is reducing the required labor force today. This points to the possibility of further change in the life of our city. The scene to the right emphasizes the importance of Lorain to the world as a port of trade.



Lorain's original stadium, which was completed in 1927, seated approximately two thousand Steeler fans.

The present stadium, shown at the left, will seat 6,000 fans. However, in a game with Lakewood the Steelmen played for 10,000 football enthusiasts.










