

LAND PURCHASES:

- 1700's.....Connecticut Western Reserve
- Early 1800's.....Pierpont Edwards purchased Avon, being Township # 7 in the Sixteenth Range of Townships in the Connecticut Western Reserve.
- 1805.....Ephraim Kyes purchased Section 11 of Township #7
- 18 October, 1831.....Robert Payne purchased 152 acres from Ephraim Kyes in Section 11.
- 16 August, 1836.....Thompson Wilder purchased 50 acres from Ephraim Kyes
- 6 January, 1882.....Martin Rinck (1st generation) purchased 28 acres from William T. (Thompson) Wilder (see parcel #4)
- 22 January, 1853.....Martin Rinck (1st Generation) purchased 85 acres from Robert Payne. (see parcel #1)
- 18 October, 1831.....Albert Kyes purchased 100 acres from Ephraim Kyes in Section 11
- 5 August, 1835.....Joshua & Mary Tucker purchased 100 acres from Albert Kyes (see parcel #2)
- 30 April, 1846.....Oliver Moon & John Warden purchased 100 acres from Joshua Tucker (see parcel #2)
- 3 September, 1849.....Morris Tucker purchased 50 acres from Oliver Moon and John Warden (see parcel #3)
- 31 March, 1857.....Martin Rinck (1st generation) purchased 50 acres from Morris Tucker (see parcel #3)
- 15 June, 1864.....Martin Rinck Sr. (1st generation) deeded 67.5 acres (one half of the 85 acres purchased from Robert Payne and the 50 acres from Morris Tucker) to William Rinck (2nd generation)
- 15 June, 1864.....Martin Rinck Sr. (1st generation) deeded 67.5 acres (one half of the 85 acres purchased from Robert Payne and the 50 acres from Morris Tucker) to Martin Rink (2nd generation) (story has it that Martin dropped the 'c' from his last name to avoid confusion for the postmaster)
