







Alamo Heights High School

SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS

The site's location on a busy street in San Antonio called for a sleek, new auditorium lobby design to unify the disparate elements of the high school facade. Interior and exterior renovations of an outdated, 1950s era auditorium into a modern, state-of-the-art facility included creation of an 1,800-square-foot black box theater with continuous catwalk, acoustical upgrades, updating theatrical light and sound system and installation of a multi-purpose floor. A new 60,580-square-foot Science Building and upgrades to campus-wide technology systems also brought the school up-to-date. Interior courtyards encourage students to learn and study before, in between and after classes, in addition to their regular class time. Classrooms are organized departmentally, with a teacher workroom at each corridor to help teachers make the most of non-class periods. The 53,530 square foot of classroom renovations as a whole created a safer environment that is easier for users to navigate.
