



Brea Sports Park

BREA, CALIFORNIA

A long-standing vision of community leaders, the Brea Sports Park provides recreational facilities that serve the public while respecting the environment, especially stormwater management. The 27-acre sports park includes ball fields, paved courts, a concession stand and a community building that were shaped by community input.

The site was originally owned by a major oil company and still has active wells that produce oil. From the onset of the yearlong community input process, stakeholders made sustainability a top priority. Green components include permeable pavers in the main promenade, fully sub-drained fields and park management best practices. Constructed bioswales address storm water issues. To hide the existing oil wells, designers positioned batting cages as screening elements
