



# Cordova Community Pool Replacement

RANCHO CORDOVA, CALIFORNIA

The Cordova Recreation and Park District (CRPD), a dedicated Parks District serving the City of Rancho Cordova, is in progress on providing a state-of-the-art aquatics centers for its community of over 110,000 people. Located in the Sacramento Valley, the Cordova Community Pool will meet both the competitive and recreation needs of the community.

Originally built in 1963, the existing facility no longer met the programmatic needs of its constituents and became challenging to maintain. CRPD engaged LPA to evaluate the feasibility of renovating the existing complex or completely replacing the three pools and support structures. LPA provided site evaluations, inventory of existing improvements, programming ideas and conceptual planning, community outreach and workshops and a full Market and Operational Study. Based on findings from these efforts, the center will include a two-pool complex with a competition lap pool, a zero-entry recreation pool with a lap swim zone and aquatic play structure, community locker rooms and enhanced guest zones like bleachers and deck areas.
