The Montgomery Middle School campus is the center of its community, with strong extra-curricular and elective programs, clubs and support groups and a health and wellness partnership with the YMCA. Part of the original 1970s campus suffered from prolonged water damage, displacing classrooms and gathering spaces into temporary modular spaces. As a result, the school district accelerated the replacement of these outdated facilities.

The new facilities are inviting to students, communicating their school is a source of pride in the community. The new two-story academic building features 18 classrooms, a library and media center, community-building cafeteria and student counseling center. Located only five miles from the ocean, the campus offers beautiful outdoor amenities for informal and formal learning opportunities, including an expansive outdoor courtyard.
