



San Marcos High School Replacement

SAN MARCOS, CALIFORNIA

Based on a Districtwide Facilities Needs Assessment completed by LPA, the \$136 million San Marcos High School project includes the phased reconstruction of the entire 40-acre project site. The facility was transformed from a 1,800-student capacity, single-story complex to a state-of-the-art, multi-story high school campus with a 3,000-student capacity. The new facility provides equity with the other district high school and includes College Prep and Career Technical Education spaces for the humanities, math/science, technology, performing arts, practical arts, agricultural sciences and special education programs. Support amenities include student services, a student union, theater/performing arts, a three-cross-court gymnasium and stadium/play fields facilities.
