1. Welcome, Roll-call & Introductions—Susan Lehnhardt

Meeting called to order at 5:30pm

2. Secretary's Report—Mindy Reinstra

3. Treasurer's Report—Meredith Tripp (submitted electronically)

See appended treasurer's report. Motion by Hansis to accept and approve treasurer's report, Foy second, motion carried 9/0. Approval requested by Tripp via Lehnhardt to pay Print Center \$121 for art show posters and post cards from the General Fund. Motion by Cardiff to approve payment, Hansis second, motion carried 9/0. Approval requested by Tripp via Lehnhardt to reimburse Bethany \$35 for Red Cedar Conference and additional expenses to RPGIV. Motion by Sheaffer to approve payment, Foy second, motion carried 9/0.

4. Action Team/Special Committee Reports

A. Organization—Nelson

 Bylaws amendment—review amendment & final approval (Lehnhardt)

Lehnhardt read the amended bylaws language which removes restrictions on consecutive director terms. **Motion by Foy to approve the amended bylaws, Sampson second, motion carried 9/0.** Lehnhardt to confirm directors whose two-year terms are up or otherwise will be on the ballot at the upcoming annual meeting (Directors on the 2016 ballot: Sampson, Sheaffer, and Foy).

2. Liability Insurance (board, events)—discuss (Lehnhardt) Emond Storm to pursue and provide quotes for events and board coverage.

3. Annual Member Meeting—update (Storm) OAT members meeting regularly to plan annual meeting.

4. QuickBooks—status of transaction entry, P&L (Straub)

Straub and team are currently entering transactions into QuickBooks and have completed those through November 2015, and will provide preliminary P&L report. The new LSRWA laptop internal battery seems to be malfunctioning—Foy to trouble-shoot laptop.

5. Annual Work Plan—status (Storm)

Emond Storm is updating the annual work plan with notes generated at the January work session.

6. Raffle Application—submission details (Lehnhardt)

Lehnhardt and Tripp completed raffle license application process, following email approval by board (see attached online voting process).

7. Fundraising/Membership Plan—meeting outcomes (Storm)

Team met with Alison Werner to continue to develop the Fundraising/Membership planning process initiated in early 2015. A subsequent work session will be scheduled with the rest of the board to discuss and refine the updated plan.
