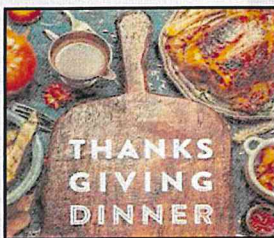


**First Sunday Tonight** Join us on the first Sunday of each month for a time of worship and the Lord's Supper at 6 PM in the Sanctuary.
