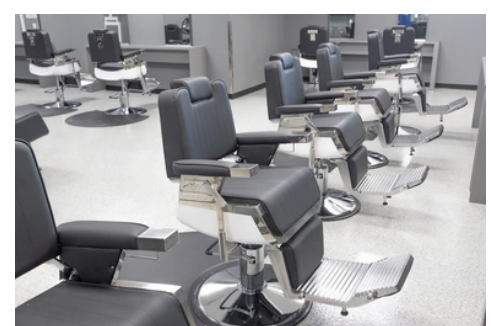
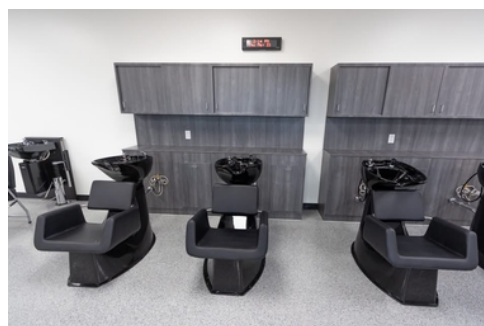
## The Studio at Erwin Technical College

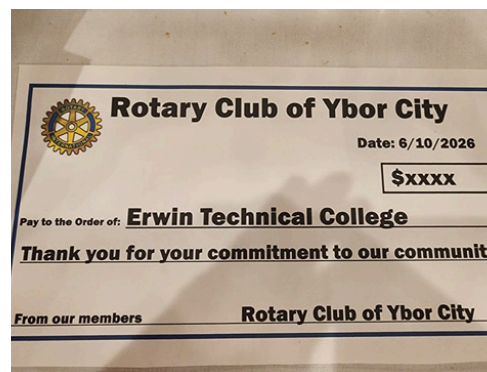
## 2026 Graduation
