

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) Consent Form

All personal content uploaded to the Memento Yearbook application is solely to be used to produce a custom yearbook for the school and is not redistributed in any form by MementoPix.

In compliance with Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) regulations, any child under the age of thirteen must have parental consent for the collection, use or disclosure of that child's personal information via a website.
