Respected Sir/Madam,

Subject: Intimation under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirement) Regulations, 2015 – Outcome of Board Meeting including the intimation of Family Settlement Agreement

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“**SEBI LODR**”), this to inform you that in the meeting of board of directors (“**Board**”) of Lux Industries Limited (“**Company**”) held today i.e., 23 April 2026, it was informed to the Board that the members of the promoter and promoter group from Todi Family of the Company have *inter-se* entered into a Family Settlement Agreement (“**FSA**”). The Company is not a party to the said FSA. The promoter and promoter group intimation dated 22 April 2026 was sent to the Compliance Officer & Company Secretary of the Company regarding the execution of the FSA (“**Promoter Declaration**”). The Promoter Declaration alongwith the details required in compliance with Regulation 30 and 30 A read with clauses 5 and 5A to para A of part A of schedule III of the SEBI LODR Regulations and applicable SEBI Circular is enclosed herewith as **Exhibit-A**.

Further at its meeting held today the Board members have evaluated and discussed various alternative structures for implementing the FSA and business reorganization. After due consideration, the Board has come to the following conclusion:

- a) **In-principle approval for demerger of Company:** The Board of the Company in their meeting dated 22nd November 2023 had approved the trifurcation of the business of LIL into 3 separate Verticals i.e., Verticals A, Vertical B and Vertical C (collectively referred to as the “**Vertical(s)**”). Pursuant to the FSA, the Board has accorded its in-principle approval for the scheme of demerger. Subject to approval from regulatory authorities and other stakeholders, the proposed scheme of demerger contemplates that on the effective date of demerger, the existing businesses of Vertical A and Vertical C would be demerged into two resulting companies, which will be subsequently listed. The business of Vertical B shall continue to remain in the Company and is proposed to be led by Shri Pradip Kumar Todi or any other member from PKT Family. One of the resulting companies to be listed for Vertical A is proposed to be led by Shri Ashok Kumar Todi or any other member from AKT Family. The other resulting company to be listed for Vertical C is proposed to be led by Shri Navin Kumar Todi or any other member from KKT Family. The AKT Family and KKT Family will cease to hold any right in the management and/or control in LIL and the PKT Family will continue to manage and control the Company. The details of each family are attached herewith in the Promoter Declaration. Further, for deliberating about the proposed demerger, the Board has approved constitution of a committee comprising of (i) Mr. Ashok Kumar Todi, Chairman and Whole-time Director; (ii) Mr.

Pradip Kumar Todi, Managing Director; (iii) Mrs. Ratnabali Kakkar, Independent Director; and (iv) Mrs. Rusha Mitra, Independent Director. Appropriate announcements and public disclosures in accordance with the SEBI Listing Regulations and other applicable laws will be made upon approval of the said scheme of demerger by the Board.

- b) Approval for incorporation of two new wholly-owned subsidiaries: For the purposes of facilitation of aforementioned demerger, approval of the Board is provided for the immediate incorporation of two wholly owned subsidiaries in West Bengal, India with the name of 'Lux' ("Proposed Subsidiaries"). On incorporation of the Proposed Subsidiaries, necessary intimation and disclosures shall be given by the Company in line with applicable provisions of SEBI Listing Regulations. Details as required under Regulation 30 of the SEBI LODR Regulations read with the SEBI Circular are enclosed herewith as **Exhibit-B**.
- c) Approval for brand licensing agreement between Company and Biswanath Hosiery Mills Limited ("BHML") for 'Lux' related brands: Pursuant to aforesaid FSA and on recommendation of the audit committee of the Company, revised brand licensing agreement is approved and executed between the Company and BHML to safeguard the Company's rights and obligations over the licensed brands, which are integral to its identity and operations and will therefore ensure continuity of brands related usage. Upon execution of such brand licensing agreement with BHML, the existing brand licensing agreement with BHML is terminated with immediate effect.
- d) Approval for brand licensing agreements between Company and (i) Biswanath Hosiery Brands Private Limited; (ii) Biswanath Brands Private Limited; (iii) PDT Realty and Investments LLP for non-'Lux' related brands: Pursuant to aforesaid FSA, the non-Lux brands owned by BHML has been assigned to other group companies of the promoter and promoter group of Todi Family. Hence on recommendation of the audit committee of the Company, three brand licensing agreements with (i) Biswanath Hosiery Brands Private Limited; (ii) Biswanath Brands Private Limited; (iii) PDT Realty and Investments LLP are approved and executed for licensing of non-Lux brands such as ONN, Lyra, GenX etc to safeguard the Company's rights and obligations over the licensed brands, which are integral to operations of the Company.

The meeting of the Board of Directors commenced at 6:00 p.m. and was concluded at 7:40 p.m.

I, Mr. Ashok Kumar Todi, write to you on behalf of the AKT Family comprising of (i) Mr. Ashok Kumar Todi; (ii) Mrs. Bimla Devi Todi; (iii) Mr. Saket Todi; (iv) Mrs. Shilpa Agarwal Samriya; (v) Mr. Upendra Samriya; (vi) Mr. Rohit Poddar; (vii) Mrs. Neha Poddar; and (viii) Priyanka Todi.

The AKT Family, PKT Family and KKT Family (collectively, the “**Todi Family**”) have entered into a Family Settlement Agreement on 22 April 2026 (“**FSA**”) to realign ownership, management and business operations of Lux Industries Limited (“**LIL**”) and its associated businesses and to ensure harmony in the future amongst the succeeding generations of the Todi family. The implementation of the FSA is subject to approval of the board of directors and shareholders of LIL as well as applicable regulatory authorities.

As a background, the Board of Directors of LIL in their meeting dated 22nd November 2023 approved the trifurcation of the business of LIL into 3 separate Verticals i.e., Verticals A, Vertical B and Vertical C (collectively referred to as the “**Vertical(s)**”).

Now, pursuant to the FSA, the promoter and Promoter group from Todi Family proposes to undertake a scheme of demerger under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, to be filed before the Hon’ble National Company Law Tribunal, Kolkata Bench. Under the proposed scheme, Vertical A and Vertical C of LIL shall be demerged into two resulting companies (both proposed to be listed), which will house the businesses of Vertical A and Vertical C, respectively, while the remaining business of LIL (demerged entity) shall comprise of Vertical B.

Upon effectiveness of the scheme and as contemplated under the FSA:

- (i) Vertical A, along with Artimas Fashions Private Limited (a subsidiary of LIL), shall be housed and merged in a separate entity and shall be managed and controlled by the AKT Family;
- (ii) Vertical B shall continue with LIL (demerged entity) and shall be managed and controlled by the PKT Family; and
- (iii) Vertical C shall be housed in a separate entity and shall be managed and controlled by the KKT Family.

Further, to ensure continuity of all brands related usage as well as to formalise and realign brand related matters, the Family Branches propose to undertake the following, subject to receipt of necessary corporate approvals:

- (i) enter into revised brand licensing agreement with Biswanath Hosiery Mills Limited (“**BHML**”) for realignment of various ‘Lux’ related brands; and
- (ii) enter into licensing arrangements for various other assigned non-lux brands of BHML.

A summary of the key provisions of the FSA has been set out in the Annexure hereto.



As a background, the Board of Directors of LIL in their meeting dated 22nd November 2023 approved the trifurcation of the business of LIL into 3 separate Verticals i.e., Verticals A, Vertical B and Vertical C (collectively referred to as the “**Vertical(s)**”).

Now, pursuant to the FSA, the promoter and Promoter group from Todi Family proposes to undertake a scheme of demerger under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, to be filed before the Hon’ble National Company Law Tribunal, Kolkata Bench. Under the proposed scheme, Vertical A and Vertical C of LIL shall be demerged into two resulting companies (both proposed to be listed), which will house the businesses of Vertical A and Vertical C, respectively, while the remaining business of LIL (demerged entity) shall comprise of Vertical B.

Upon effectiveness of the scheme and as contemplated under the FSA:

- (i) Vertical A, along with Artimas Fashions Private Limited (a subsidiary of LIL), shall be housed and merged in a separate entity and shall be managed and controlled by the AKT Family;
- (ii) Vertical B shall continue with LIL (demerged entity) and shall be managed and controlled by the PKT Family; and
- (iii) Vertical C shall be housed in a separate entity and shall be managed and controlled by the KKT Family.

Further, to ensure continuity of all brands related usage as well as to formalise and realign brand related matters, the Family Branches propose to undertake the following, subject to receipt of necessary corporate approvals:

- (i) enter into revised brand licensing agreement with Biswanath Hosiery Mills Limited (“**BHML**”) for realignment of various ‘Lux’ related brands; and
- (ii) enter into licensing arrangements for various other assigned non-lux brands of BHML.

A summary of the key provisions of the FSA has been set out in the Annexure hereto.

As a background, the Board of Directors of LIL in their meeting dated 22nd November 2023 approved the trifurcation of the business of LIL into 3 separate Verticals i.e., Verticals A, Vertical B and Vertical C (collectively referred to as the “**Vertical(s)**”).

Now, pursuant to the FSA, the promoter and Promoter group from Todi Family proposes to undertake a scheme of demerger under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, to be filed before the Hon’ble National Company Law Tribunal, Kolkata Bench. Under the proposed scheme, Vertical A and Vertical C of LIL shall be demerged into two resulting companies (both proposed to be listed), which will house the businesses of Vertical A and Vertical C, respectively, while the remaining business of LIL (demerged entity) shall comprise of Vertical B.

Upon effectiveness of the scheme and as contemplated under the FSA:

- (i) Vertical A, along with Artimas Fashions Private Limited (a subsidiary of LIL), shall be housed and merged in a separate entity and shall be managed and controlled by the AKT Family;
- (ii) Vertical B shall continue with LIL (demerged entity) and shall be managed and controlled by the PKT Family; and
- (iii) Vertical C shall be housed in a separate entity and shall be managed and controlled by the KKT Family.

Further, to ensure continuity of all brands related usage as well as to formalise and realign brand related matters, the Family Branches propose to undertake the following, subject to receipt of necessary corporate approvals:

- (i) enter into revised brand licensing agreement with Biswanath Hosiery Mills Limited (“**BHML**”) for realignment of various ‘Lux’ related brands; and
- (ii) enter into licensing arrangements for various other assigned non-lux brands of BHML.

A summary of the key provisions of the FSA has been set out in the Annexure hereto.
