

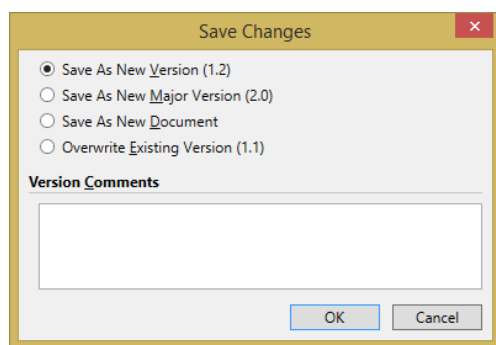

MacroView AOI enhances the user experience when you close or use Save As on a Microsoft Word or Excel document that has been opened from SharePoint for editing. The AOI dialog provides options similar to those provided by a traditional document management system.



Significantly, MacroView AOI does not display the *Do you wish to discard checkout?* prompt which is displayed by the OOB integration between Microsoft Word and SharePoint, but causes the inadvertent loss of all changes made to the document since it was checked out if Yes is selected.

## New in this release

- Supports for Microsoft Excel documents.
- Refreshed dialog layouts and icons
- Support for creating new major versions when saving changes to a minor versions library.
- Support for overwriting the current version if minor versions are enabled and the current version is not a published version.
- Support for saving and overwriting minor document versions.
- Supports for saving to libraries with no versioning enabled.
- Support for saving as new document or overwriting existing document when versioning is disabled.
- Dropped .NET Framework 3.5 SP1 requirement

## Bug Fixes

- Save As New Document on close no longer prematurely closes the document which could result in the new document containing the old footer.
- Closing a document when edits have been previously saved no longer results in an incorrect footer when minor versions are enabled.
- Clicking "Save As to SharePoint" and saving as new version or overwriting existing version no longer causes document to close if user previously cancelled a close from the Save Changes dialog.
- Red 'X' dialog cancel buttons now cancel the dialogs rather than accepting the default action of the dialog.
- Successful save dialog no longer appears if saving a new document fails.
