Bug Fixes

- Resolved an issue with Favorites not being updated when switching modes in Outlook or executing a Refresh or Delete in Outlook or DMF Explorer.
- Resolved an issue with the refresh indicator not showing in Browse mode after creating a sub node in Favorites.
- Resolved an issue which could cause Search Site Tree to return no results when there is a problem reading the users Favourites.
- Resolved an issue which could result in custom date properties not being saved when drag and dropping emails to Tree View in Outlook.
- Navigate to URL now works when initiated from a site collection or a subsite node with Navigate to Site homepage in Outlook enabled.

Important information about this release

MacroView DMF 7.10 required Microsoft Framework v4.5.2 and .NET Programmability for Microsoft Office. Before installing the MacroView DMF 7.10 Client you should ensure that these prerequisites are available on the workstation.

When upgrading from DMF 7.9.5054 through DMF 7.10.38 you must shutdown the DMF local service before installing later versions of the client to ensure unsaved recents and favorites are retained.
