Photo & Video Guide

I. PHOTO SPECS

- 1. One from player's view including the entire instrument
- 2. One from audience view including the entire instrument
- 3. One of the logo if applicable with partial instrument in view
- 4. One aerial showing the entire keyboard
- 5. Two angle shots from each respective end
- 6. Special feature shots (resonators/height adjustment etc.)
- 7. Photo(s) of cover / case(s) if applicable
- 8. Photo size should be 2500px / 600kb and in .jpg format
- *Leave margins on side of entire instrument shots to allot for clean edges & cropping.
- *If possible hang a white sheet (background/floor). All photos will be lifted from background. If unable to do so, please use a blank wall with no other fixtures (doors/windows/photos) in view.
- *Please refer to current listings as an example.

II. VIDEO SPECS

- 1. Record from overhead
- 2. Hold camera horizontally in right hand
- 3. Zoom on mallet with neighboring bars in view; no other extraneous items in view, avoid arm/hand in view
- 4. Use the left hand to play an ascending chromatic scale (not too slow nor too fast ~ eighth note = 50-60 bpm)
- 5. Make a tight shot on the mallet so only the keys show when you play. Focus on the median between accidentals and naturals
