## 1. Bug Fixes

### [CORE-1174] - Predefined Fees are deleted when a GET Loan Accounts API call is performed

When retrieving the list of all loan accounts with disbursement fees via GET API call (using [https://\[address\]/api/loans/](https://[address]/api/loans/) call on API 1.0 or API 2.0) without fullDetails parameter, the disbursement fees information was deleted from database and UI, even if at this call they were returned in the API response. After the second run of the GET API call, the disbursement fees weren't returned in the response either.

In V7.3 version, Mambu fixed this issue and now the disbursement fees are not deleted anymore when getting the list of loan accounts via GET API call with fullDetails parameter.

**Note:** if you've posted loan accounts with disbursement fees and after that you've retrieved them using GET all loan accounts API call without fullDetails parameter after V7 Production release (please note that if you GET a loan account based on loanID or with fullDetails parameter, this issue cannot be reproduced), you will need to re-post the disbursement fees (for accounts that are not active yet). For active and closed loan accounts, we will do a migration script in order to return the disbursement fees in API response in one of the next Minor Release version.
