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1. Bug Fixes

[FIX-472] - Reversed transactions are still displayed if Journal Entries are filtered by Was Reversed is No filter

When applying the filter Was Reversed = No, the reversed transactions were displayed. In V8.8, Mambu fixed the issue and now the reversed transactions are not longer displayed after applying the filter.

[FIX-536] - Cannot Create an Account via API if the Loan Amount is set to 0

When trying to create a loan account for an Interest Free loan product, with loan amount 0, via API, the following error message was displayed "loan amount is required". In V8.8, Mambu fixed the issue and now it is possible to create loan account for an Interest Free loan product with loan amount 0 via API.

[DEP-552] - Cannot backdate a deposit for an imported savings account

This issue occurred in relation to the interest accrual and application when backdating a deposit transaction on imported savings accounts. When interest was applied after backdating some transactions, then no further deposit transactions could be backdated. The issue has now been fixed and all deposit transactions can now be backdated for imported savings accounts regardless of interest application.

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
