1. Improvements

[CORE-4] - Loan transaction API should return status 500 Internal Server Error when applying a repayment on a closed account

With this improvement , Mambu updated the status code of the API request to apply a repayment on a closed account. Before this release, we were handling this scenario with '500 Internal Server Error' whereas the expected correct response should have been '400 Bad Request'.

2. Bug Fixes

[CUS-45] - Default Custom Preset is deleted from Custom Columns menu after editing any user owner field

With this release, Mambu fixed the problem in which users were losing all their Default Presets after a change was applied on the Admin user that created the Preset. Since Admin user's passwords were changed on a frequent basis this issue was affecting all non-admin users that had that Custom Columns Preset saved as their default, as it was no longer displayed in the Custom Columns menu.

[CORE-10] - Unable to Refinance a loan account when the outstanding principal amount has decimals and rounding is enabled on the product

When attempting to reschedule a loan account having declining balance equal installments with 'Round Payment Due Up to the Nearest Whole Unit' rounding method, we were getting an error message: "Decimals not allowed when rounding is enabled" for the 'Current Outstanding Principal' field. With this release, Mambu removed this validation allowing users to create/refinance/reschedule such a loan account. The loan products that don't support DBEI will not be affected by this change.
