[CUS-471] - Gaps in sending notifications on shared environments

During analysis, we noticed that the notification sending mechanism is paused for some time causing delays in the delivery of notifications (~minutes). With this release, Mambu changed the locking mechanism in order to provide better performance.

[CUS-469] - Lazy fetching on Edit and View rights for Custom Fields

Mambu identified an issue when operating on the UI, with custom fields Edit and View permissions unchecked. With this task, we've fixed the caching mechanism of custom fields to correctly populate custom fields links when previously mentioned permissions are not granted.
