1. Bug fixes

[ADM-231] - Portofolio Report is ran on master instead or read replica or secondary read replica

This fix prevents cases where due to high data load, requests on portfolio reports cause connection pool timeouts and do not continue running until finished. With this fix, portfolio reports will be ran on a read replica and will successfully complete.

[ADM-166] - Reduce the number of database connections after cron startup

When database connections exceed the maximum limit, cron machines might not be initialized properly and notifications might not be delivered as expected. With this fix, we reduced the number of database connections in order to provide better performance.

[NEO-309] - Api and desktop calls fail randomly due to various exceptions

When using custom fields which contain selections related to other custom fields, specific API and desktop calls were not working properly. This inconvenience has now been resolved.
