1. Bugs

KMBU-140 - Import is still running after an exception is thrown

When performing an import, the import would continue running even after an exception was thrown.

Mambu has corrected this behaviour and the import will continue in spite of the exception being thrown.

MBU-18716 - Exception is logged during the nightly cron jobs when sending notifications for groups

When using a notification template, such as SMS, with Credit Officer as recipient, and used for a pure loan group product which is available for group targets, with at least one client added to the group and the client set with a group role (such as "President"), but without any Credit Officer set for the account, an exception would be thrown.

Mambu has addressed this and no exceptions should be thrown anymore.

2. Improvements

KMBU-107 - Exception thrown during sandbox cloning

When a clone of sandbox is performed, the old sandbox database is removed and a new one is being created, however due to users still being logged in the previous sandbox environment, some exceptions would be thrown.

To address this, Mambu will automatically logout the users from the sandbox instance that is being removed, while the cloning is ongoing.
