In V4.6.6 Mambu introduced a more restrictive API calls for EMPTY filter element. In that restriction for this filter element the user was not allowed to provide any value. Even though this should be the correct behaviour, the change broke the functionality for some existing tenants. With 4.6.9 Mambu fixed this inconvenience and the given values for the specific filter element will be ignored.
