1. Bug Fixes

[ADM-280] - Integrate Plumbr Javascript/Client agent in Mambu code

Plumbr was integrated as a monitoring solution for root cause analysis.

[CUS-374] - Custom Field "Usage/Rights" section greyed out and not clickable

After editing the second time a custom field, the "Rights" section became greyed out and it cannot be edited. We had to refresh the page, in order to be able to edit it. In V5.12, Mambu fixed this problem and now, the "Rights" section can be edited without refreshing the page.

[CORE-641] - Reduce the penalties in the order they were applied

The penalties are not present on the schedule, they are only present in the penalty due balance. When we have multiple penalties applied, we should reduce them from the first transaction of penalty that was applied, in order to be consistent with fees and interests.

[CORE-634] - "LAST_MODIFIED_DATE" field value is not updated in database after the account is modified via a holiday action or a centre action

When the schedule was modified due to a holiday or a centre meeting day, the "LAST_MODIFIED_DATE" field from the database remained the same with the disbursement transaction date. In V5.12 Mambu fix this issue and now the "LAST_MODIFIED_DATE" is correctly updated when a holiday or centre meeting day was added.

[CORE-500] - Null Type summaries are created even though the entry has a Balance value

At database level, even if the balance for a GL Account was greater than 0, the type of it was null, because, at some point, when the summaries were calculated, the difference between debit and credit was 0, therefore the balance was 0 and the type null. In V5.12 Mambu fixed this problem and we do not have anymore null type at database level.
