1. Bug Fixes

[ADM-378] - Unable to reset a users' password with 'Edit User' permission

A non-Admin user with create/edit user permissions and access to all branches was not able to reset the password of another user with access to all branches. In V5.17, Mambu fixed this issue and non-admin users that can manage all branches will now be able to edit and reset the password of users that are not assigned to a specific branch.

[CUS-32] - After deleting a custom field that was included in a custom view or custom filter, an unexpected error is displayed when trying to edit the custom view

When trying to save a custom view or custom filter after deleting a custom field the action is not performed due to an error.

In V5.17, Mambu fixed this issue and when deleting a custom field from a custom view or custom filter the action is performed and the data fields are reindexed.
