## 1. Bug Fixes

### **[DEP-309] - Backdate deposit transaction permission is needed to make a disbursement into a deposit account in the current moment**

When a user that has Disburse account and Make Deposit permissions, but without having the permission to Backdate Deposit Transactions, tries to disburse the loan account into a savings account in the present time the Permission Denied error message is displayed, even if the disbursement is not done backdated.

In V5.23, Mambu fixed this issue and the disbursement of a loan account into a deposit account at the current moment is possible if Disburse Account and Make Deposit permissions are enabled to the user. If the disbursement has to be made in the past then the Disburse Account, Make Deposit and Backdate Deposit Transactions permission are needed.
