[CUS-580] - Notifications are not sent/created when a deactivated template exists for the same event

If we had 2 notification templates for the same event, one inactive and one active, the notification wasn't sent or displayed in Communication tab because we checked only the first template. In Mambu V5.6 we fixed this issue and now we go through all the list of notification templates.

[CUS-477] - In Instalments custom views taxes are included in Interest related fields for Fixed Term accounts

For the fixed accounts, in Installments custom views, for interest related columns, the amount displayed was equal with interest amount plus taxes amount. With this fix from Mambu V5.6 we display the interest amount without tax amount in Installments custom view, in order to reflect the interest columns from the schedule.
