

## **Speaking in Toungues**

When greeting someone else, English speaking people typically say, "Hello!" The same behavior and salutation is found in many other languages, as well. For example, in France, their word for greeting one another is, "Bonjour!" In Spanish speaking countries they say "Hola!" and in Germany it is, "Hallo!" Italians say "Ciao," Japanese say "Konichi wa," Israeli's say "Shalom," Hindus say "Namaste," and in Swahili they say "Jambo!" The human custom of greeting one another is basically the same all around the globe, it is just "flavored" with various language and cultural differences. Thus, knowing the native tongue of another culture helps someone better communicate their needs, desires, and ideas across the language barrier. It is a rather simple concept that almost everyone seems to understand ... except when it comes to the Bible!



For some reason, when "tongues" are mentioned in the Bible (which is simply a synonym for "languages") many religious minded people suddenly lose their sense of reasoning! For years, false teachers have fabricated the idea that "speaking in tongues" (Mark 16:17; Acts 2:4, 10:46, 19:6; 1 Corinthians 12:10,28,30, 13:1, 14:5) is a spiritual gift that is "the practice of uttering speech-like sounds that are not recognizable as a human language." Furthermore, they erroneously teach that this miraculous ability is still available to Christians today. In fact, one can easily find churches where "speaking in tongues" is part of their worship activities. So, is it true? What does the Bible say about "speaking in tongues"? Here are three, quick Bible facts concerning the practice:

- 1. God used tongues to propagate the Gospel. In Acts 2, the Apostles "were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance" (v4). At least fifteen distinct nations or ethnic groups are mentioned in that same passage, who responded with, "How is it that we hear, each in our own language in which we were born?" (v8). The tongues were known languages, not some "angelic gibberish." It was God's method for immediately spreading the Gospel into all cultures and languages.
- 2. Speaking in tongues was for church edification, not personal attention. 1 Corinthians 14:26-28 says that spiritual gifts were for building up and encouraging the church. Furthermore, "if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God," (v28). Once again, it is not some "unrecognizable language" that people utter and no one else understands, as is practiced among some religious groups. Such practices pridefully bring attention to the individual, instead of to God.
- 3. Speaking in tongues was a miraculous ability (spiritual gift) that has ceased. Paul wrote, "whether there are tongues, they will cease;" (1 Cor 13:8). When would this happen? He continues, "when that which is perfect has come," (v10). Speaking in tongues would not last forever because it had a specific purpose: "confirming the word through the accompanying signs," (Mark 16:20). The world did not yet have the New Testament in written form, so this spiritual gift help spread the Good News to all nations in their own language. But once it was completed and delivered to all the world (Col 1:5-6; Jude 3),

then speaking in tongues was no longer needed. Thus, the spiritual gift ceased and is no longer available to Christians today. Therefore, if God wants to say "Hello" or communicate with us

in our native language, we have copies of His perfect Word readily available to us!
