

# 7 Ways To Be a "Barnabas" (Encourager)

The Book of Acts talks about a unique individual, described slightly different than others. "And Joses, who was also named Barnabas by the apostles (which is translated Son of Encouragement)" (Acts 4:36). Barnabas was given a nickname by the Apostles because of a particular personality trait he possessed, he was an encourager. That is quite a compliment! Wouldn't it be wonderful if all Christians were known by that same characteristic? Are you an encourager? You should be. We should all be more like Barnabas. Here are just a few suggestions that might help you become a "Barnabas":

#### 1. Pray for someone to encourage

The first step toward any character change begins with bathing it in prayer. Ask God to use you as an encourager, to help you identify one who needs encouragement. Ask for strength and wisdom in how to best lift someone up, whether it be a stranger, an acquaintance, family, or one of your own brethren. (cf. 1 Thessalonians 3:12)

#### 2. Phone calls, Cards, Letters, and Email

In this modern age of communication, there are so many avenues available to us for connecting with others. A personal phone call, a letter, even a text, or an email is enough to encourage almost anyone who receives it. The more personal touch you can add, the better. Just remember, nothing encourages someone more than doing so face to face. (cf. Hebrews 10:25)



#### 3. Use Social Media to Exhort

There is no shortage of distressing news, complaining, and vitriol posted on social media outlets these days. Why not show the attitude of Barnabas to the world by becoming known as a great encourager on Facebook, Twitter, or other platforms? It is rather easy to be a shining light in such a dark place because so few people are encouragers. (cf. Eph 5:8)

#### 4. Offer Prayers

Ask someone if you can pray for them. Inquire if there is anything specific that they would like for you to pray to God about. Then, pray right there in that moment with them! This can be so encouraging to those who are struggling with life's difficulties, diseases, or demands. It is an extremely effective and godly way to encourage others. (cf. James 5:16)

#### 5. Notice Strangers

We interact with people every day: waiters, cashiers, mechanics, receptionists, sales clerks, couriers, etc. They also interact with many people everyday who, typically, don't treat them very kindly. Giving them respect, a smile, or even a word of encouragement is almost always appreciated. It will make their day and your light will shine! (cf. Matt 5:16)

#### 6. Smile! A lot!

Sounds simple enough, but sometimes not so easy to actually do. Yet, a smile is one of the easiest, most effective ways to encourage someone else. Smiles are contagious! It communicates love and positive feelings. You will feel better yourself and that usually radiates out to others. Barnabas most likely smiled a lot, don't you think? (Acts 11:23; Job 9:27)

#### 7. Imitate Other Encouragers

One of the best ways to learn how to do something well is to watch others who do it well. Notice what they say, how they say it, and what methods they use. It can also help you identify what works best for you. Become aware of what encourages you and then go do that to others. Barnabas is certainly a great role model! (1 Corinthians 11:1)

Become a "Barnabas" because the world needs more godly encouragers!
