POLISHING THE PULPIT

I have had many ask me about *Polishing the Pulpit*. What is it? What is it about? Is it just for preachers, or for everyone? I thought it might be useful to write some information here to explain a little more. We certainly recommend ALL brethren attend! It is an incredible experience of Christian fellowship, learning, and one that will greatly increase your faith!

Polishing the Pulpit (also known as "PTP") is an annual event associated with churches of Christ. It is held each July in Branson, MO and each August in the Sevierville, TN. It is attended by over 5,000 people from all over the U.S. and many nations. It offers more than 700 sessions and 150 speakers each year, all focused on one goal: bringing God the glory. It is several days of worshiping God, edifying His children, and educating/training His workers. Its motto is: "Renew, Refresh, and Recharge." It is also an opportunity for continuing education for preachers and all members of the church. It offers classes specifically for elders, for deacons, youth workers, Bible class teachers, missionaries, and also Spanish speakers. There are also many displays of brotherhood works and services.



Polishing the Pulpit is Family Friendly. There is something for everyone. There are classes and activities for men, women, children, teens, singles, couples, families, widows, empty-nesters, new-converts, missionaries, and more. It is the one event that many entire families look forward to every year and they count down the days until they can return.

Polishing the Pulpit began with an idea. Three friends got together to brainstorm sermon ideas. They eventually invited other friends, and someone said, "This is great! We should tell others." So, they did and invited a speaker to discuss sermon preparation and give sample sermons. Interest increased; more speakers were invited. Then, they moved to a hotel conference area. They started to dream big, "Let's invite the best speakers in the brotherhood and see who we can get." The speakers came. Then wives wanted to be a part of it, so they added women's classes. Having so many great speakers assembled in one place, they decided to offer classes for elders. They loved it! More and more people began coming from all over the country. Youth workers and deacons became interested. So they added more tracks for them. PTP moved to an even larger event center in the Smoky Mountains - Sevierville, TN. Attendance approached 1,000. "Why don't you have classes for regular members?" they were asked. So the added the Spiritual Renewal Weekend, as well as tracks for members, teens, and children. Attendance has since passed 5,000! An entire generation has now grown up going to PTP!
