

Are You a Saint?

"Are YOU a saint?" Has anyone ever asked you that, or called you a "saint"? If they did, it was most likely said in a rather mocking or sarcastic tone. That is because it is often used as a derogatory quip when someone is behaving as if they were perfect, better than everyone else, or claiming innocence within the context of the moment. It is derived from those who are commonly called, or named "Saints," such as: Saint Peter, Saint Patrick, Saint Francis of Assisi, or even Saint Joan of Arc. When we hear such names, we usually think of someone who is quite special, standing above others, and exemplary of someone who is certainly good and righteous. We are familiar with several remarkable, historical personalities that have had the title, "Saint" bestowed upon them. In our modern society, one certainly doesn't go around requesting, or expecting to be addressed as a "Saint." Thus, if one uses that term for someone else, it's typically in the form of an insult.

Yet, did you know that **if you are a Christian, that is, a baptized and faithful disciple of Jesus Christ, you are, indeed, a saint?** Christians are known as, or called by many other names in the Scriptures. Some of those names include: "child of God" (1 John 3:1); "follower" (1 Thessalonians 1:6); "brethren" (Hebrews 3:1); and also by the word "saint" (Romans 1:7; 1 Corinthians 1:2). These are all synonyms meaning the same thing, that is, it is one who is a member of the Lord's church, a disciple of Jesus.

The idea that a "saint" is a term reserved only for a few perfect, venerated, and extremely virtuous (almost mythological) personalities is a worldly construct - it is not how the Bible uses the term! The Bible describes a saint as one who is "in Christ Jesus,"

(Philippians 4:21), and as "faithful brethren" in Colossians 1:2. They are also said to be "called to be saints" (Romans 1:7; 1 Cor 1:2). These are all references to someone who has obeyed the Gospel to become a Christian. The only way to get "into" Jesus is through obedience to the Gospel call (Galatians 3:27; Acts 2:47).

Therefore, if you have obeyed the Gospel, by having heard it (Romans 10:17), believed it (John 3:16), repented of your sins (Luke 13:3; Acts 17:30), confessed that Jesus is the Son of God (Matthew 10:32; Acts 8:37) and been baptized for the remission of your sins (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38, 22:16), then you are a saint! You have have been added to the Lord's church and are now a member of the Lord's body, that is, His kingdom. Paul clarifies this in Ephesians 2:19 with, "Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God." He also identifies members of the Lord's church as "Saints" in many of his letters, "as in all the churches of the saints." (1 Cor 14:33; 2 Cor 1:1; Eph 1:1; Phil 1:1; Col 1:2).

The word "Saint" is derived from the same root word translated as "sanctified," (Greek: *hagios*, G39) meaning something that is set apart, or consecrated from common use for a more specific and righteous purpose. That is exactly what Christians are! They are separated from the world (John 17:16) to be devoted to God's divine purposes (2 Timothy 2:21; Titus 2:14; 1 Peter 2:9). That is why Paul would write, "*To the church of God which is*

at Corinth, to those **who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints**, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord." (1 Cor 1:2) So, if you are a Christian, then being called a "saint" is not anything offensive. Instead, it is a true blessing to be called by that name!


