

How to KNOW You are Saved

I can't tell you how many people outside the church I have met and ministered to believe that they are saved, yet their actions and words reveal they are not. When they tell me they were baptized as a baby, received a miraculous vision, just "felt it," or something similar, it is a clear indication that they are not saved. It is clear, not because I think so, but because the Bible is clear about what one must do to be saved. One must hear the Gospel (John 10:27; Romans 10:17); believe that Jesus is the Son of God (John 3:16); repent of their sins (Luke 13:3); confess their belief in Jesus (Matt 10:32; Acts 8:37); be baptized for the remission of sins (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38, 22:16). That is the Biblical pattern - the only method - by which one is saved and added to the church (Acts 2:47). That is how one can know if they are saved, by doing precisely what the Bible prescribes. If one has done anything short of or outside of that divine pattern, well, they simply are not saved.

Yet, I have also ministered to many brethren who have obeyed the Gospel by fulfilling the requirements of God's plan of salvation, who still doubt if they are truly saved! If I ask them, "Do you *know* you are saved?" they respond with, "I *think* I am saved," or "I *hope* I am saved." In other words, even though they have done exactly what God said to do to be saved, they're still not *certain* they are saved! That is truly sad, and my heart hurts for them. It seems so ironic that many of my friends who clearly haven't obeyed the Gospel according to the Bible are so confident in their "salvation," while some of my own brethren who have obeyed correctly are not confident in their salvation!



Here is a simple, two-step assessment for how you can be absolutely certain that you are saved, or not:

- 1. Obey the Gospel according to the Scriptural pattern (outlined above, demonstrated repeatedly in the Book of Acts, and confirmed in other passages like Romans 6:1-8; Galatians 3:27; 1 Peter 3:21).
- **2. Remain faithful until death** (Revelation 2:10). This implies, of course, that one can fall from grace (Gal 5:4), return to sin (Heb 10:26), and are no longer saved (1 Tim 3:7, 4:1). Thus, we must constantly be obedient and faithful in our Christian walk so that we can receive the reward of heaven.

So, have you done / are you doing those two things? If "yes," then you can be certain that you are saved!

God wants you to be certain, to have assurance of your salvation, the hope of eternal life. Hebrews 10:22 says, "Let us draw near with a true heart **in full assurance of faith**, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water." That is why He made it so simple for one to come to Him, through Jesus, by obeying the Gospel (isn't it strange that people want to complicate or change such a simple plan?). He also provided the New Testament and the examples of the first disciples to help us understand that assuredness. Assurance is the very substance of faith (see Hebrews 11:1)! God wants you to be certain of your salvation.

Still concerned if you are saved or not? Then listen to what the Apostle John says about the subject, "Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom

he has given us." (1 John 3:24) He also wrote, "By this we know that we abide in him and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit." (1 John 4:13). If you have obeyed the Gospel and you are keeping God's commands, then you CAN be certain that you are saved!


