I Know What You Are Thinking!

"I know what you are thinking!" is an interesting phrase that is used in a few different ways. If stated in a dismissive or judgmental tone, it implies not being interested in hearing someone else's thoughts or feelings on a subject. If stated in an an overly confident, or presumptuous tone, it implies that one believes they know another person's thoughts better than they do themselves. Or, if it's stated in a more playful or empathetic tone, it's simply an indication that someone recognizes what another is going through, or trying to communicate. The truth of all of these, however, is that absolutely no one actually knows what someone else is thinking!

We do not have the ability to read someone else's mind, or see their thoughts in any external form. We can only speculate as to what they are thinking from their tone of voice, body language, a few other context clues, and we often make an incorrect assessment at that. To say, "I know what you are thinking," is to assert something that simply is not true! It is assigning one's own opinion to that of another without absolute proof and often stated by someone with a cognitive bias of overestimating their abilities. Yet, it's still something many people do to God on a regular basis! Many assume to know what God thinks and/or assign their own opinion or ideas as to what He will or will not do, and is or is not!



The most ironic part of all that is, God is the only One who <u>can</u> actually read one's thoughts! In reality, only **God truly knows what you are thinking!** We know this from what an inspired psalmist wrote, "The LORD knows the thoughts of man, That they are futile." (Psalm 94:11) Or, from what we find in passages like 1 Samuel 16:7, But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." In other words, God can see things about a person that we cannot. Furthermore, Jesus (who was God in the flesh on earth - John 1:14) is noted as being able to know one's thoughts, But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts?" (Matthew 9:4) The Bible gives clear indication that our Creator, His Son, and the Holy Spirit have the capability of seeing into our souls and discerning our thoughts.

As far as any human knowing what or how God thinks, He addressed that point, as well, through one of His inspired prophets, saying, "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," says the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts." (Isaiah 55:8-9) Let me also add that "God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent." (Numbers 23:19) Essentially, we can not assign or ascribe any of our human traits to God. While we are made in His image (Genesis 1:26,27), Yahweh is different than man. He is the "potter and we are the clay" (Isaiah 64:8). He is a divine spirit (John 4:24), eternal King, immortal, infinite, invisible deity of heaven (1 Timothy 1:17)! We, on the other hand, are finite and nothing more than mortal flesh and blood.

Understanding this eternal order of things should help us to better apply the teaching of James 4:10 to our lives, "Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up."

He already knows your deepest thoughts! So, why not give Him your all?
