

ANGER

One of the common denominators I find among all the news media outlets and social media platforms is anger, lots and lots of anger. Almost every news topic or social network post is filled with various forms of anger. People are protesting this and that because they are angry. Lawmakers are debating and pontificating because they are angry. Corporate executives and blue collar workers are at each other's throats because they are angry. Every channel and every site you go to seems to have an element of anger at the core of the topic. The truth is, all media content producers (from TV, radio, print media, and internet sites) know that human nature leans more towards "negativity bias" than some uplifting, positive news piece. Presenting content that is contentious or controversial will draw far more attention than anything that's cheerful and constructive.



Indeed, anger is one of the most fundamental human emotions, alongside happiness, sadness, love, and fear. Its intensity can range from mild annoyance to being violently enraged. It's commonly triggered as a response to betrayal, rejection, or perceived unfairness. However, even though anger may be a popular topic among media producers and a fundamental human emotion, Christians should be more concerned with what God has to say about the subject. What does God expect of His children concerning anger? What does the Bible teach about being angry?

Perhaps, the first verse that comes to mind for many is Ephesians 4:26, "Be angry and do not sin. Do not let the sun go down on your wrath." The Bible clearly recognizes anger as a human behavior, but it also always places limitations on it. In

fact, almost every verse in the Bible that deals with human anger, condemns it because it is connected to pride. Yet sadly, people frequently use this verse to justify their anger instead of accepting responsibility for it.

The phrase "righteous indignation" is often used to describe what a Christian is allowed to do/be. The verse in Ephesians and the occasion of Jesus overturning tables (Matt 21:12; Mark 11:15; John 2:15) are used to justify and support the concept. But, that notion is a human construct. Any astute Bible student will quickly recognize such a phrase is not found in Scripture, and the Bible never actually says that Jesus was angry when He overturned the tables! We simply deduce that He was angry and assign that emotion to Him, but the word itself is never found connected to Him in that incident. Even in Mark 3:5 when Jesus was "angry" as He looked around at the people, the writer qualifies it by saying "because He was grieved at their hardness of heart." Or, even the word "indignant" (in the NIV in Mark 1:41), is better translated as "pity, or compassion." In addition, if God IS love, as stated in 1 John 4:8, then why wouldn't the same apply to Jesus, as God on earth (Phil 2:6-8)? If He is love (meaning His entire being), then anger could not be a part of His character.

The main takeaway is this: every human being struggles with anger in varying degrees, so let's allow God's Word to teach us how to overcome sinful anger and handle it in a godly manner. Let us focus more on being

pleasing to God instead of allowing our anger to "give place to the devil" (Eph 4:27). "Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God!" (James 1:19-20)


