



Community Health & Safety | Summer Term 2021

The health of everyone in our community remains our top priority. These measures will allow us to engage with young people while maintaining deep connection and collaboration in a safe way.

- Each Summer Term course (8 total) will have the option to meet for one session (1.5 hours on one day) in person in Marwen's parking lot.
- There is also a possibility for each course to go off site as part of an outdoor field trip. This will be shared by the teaching artist cohort in advance of the off site day.
- Onsite sessions will take place in Marwen's parking lot under tents and beneath the building's entrance overhang.
- Masks will be required outside. Marwen will provide masks to anyone who needs one.
- Materials and surfaces will be disinfected after each session. Restrooms will be disinfected before, during, and after each session.
- Access to the building will be limited to water refills and restroom facilities; masks are required to enter.
- Limited parking (approximately 10-15 spaces) will be available during onsite sessions. Metered parking is available nearby.
- Marwen is not requiring proof of vaccination to teach or participate in summer programming. Over 80% of Marwen staff are fully vaccinated as of June 2021.
