Certificate in Interior Design

The Interior Design Certificate develops students' knowledge in space design, materials and furnishing. Students will apply the principles of good design when planning the arrangement of furnishings and aesthetic details for an environment in which people live and work. Students will also learn the principles, methods and tools for establishing and running their own interior design business.

Successful graduates of the program will be able to:

1. Use the principles of interior and architectural design following best practice guidelines.
2. Identify interior design needs through critical analysis, decision-making skills, and problem-solving skills.
3. Identify and create solutions for ethical issues in the interior design environment.
4. Evaluate ways in which professionals in the interior design environment can adapt to the diverse and changing needs of their client base.
5. Prepare and deliver creative graphic and oral presentations for residential and commercial interior designs using computer-assisted design (CAD).
