As days became weeks, and weeks became months, we, as a unit and as inde-

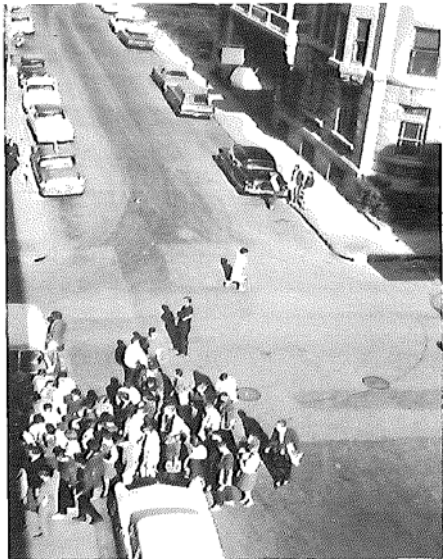

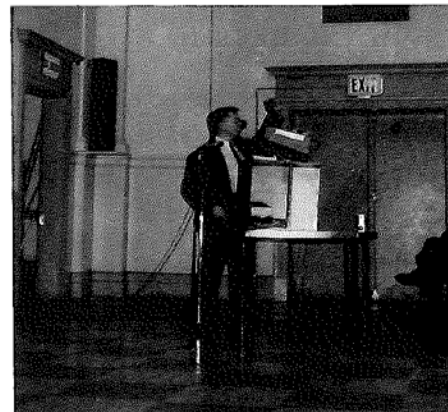
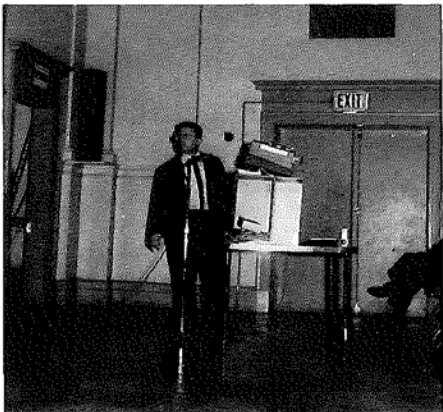


Student Humanities Club

There are plans to expand the activities of the Club to include a separate group for literary activities.



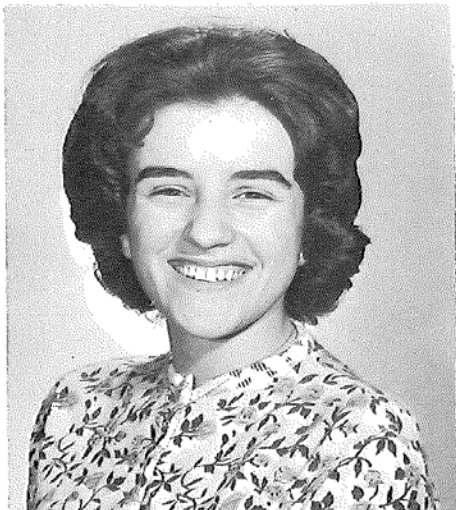
Secretarial Club

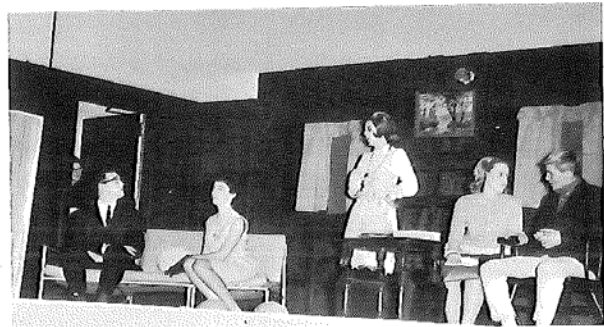
This organization, still in its embryonic stages, is under the direction of Miss McGuire, a member of our faculty, who founded it after she had received several suggestions from students for such a club.

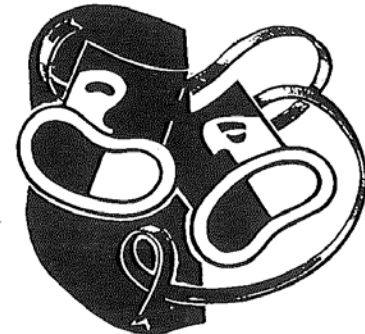
Drama Club

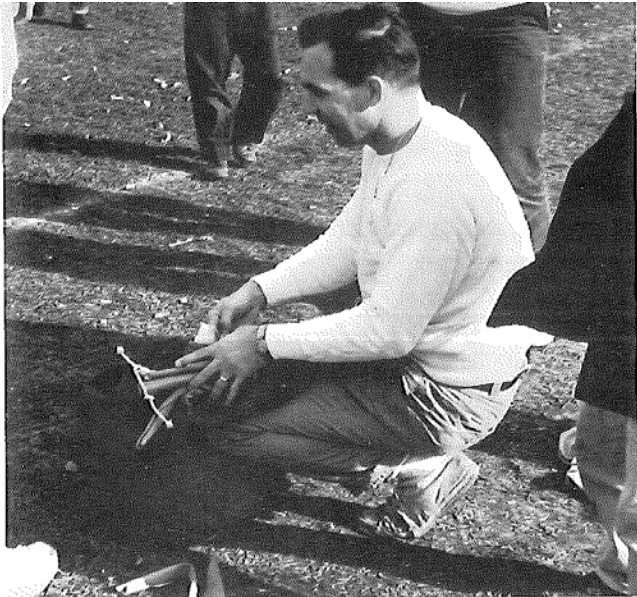
French Club

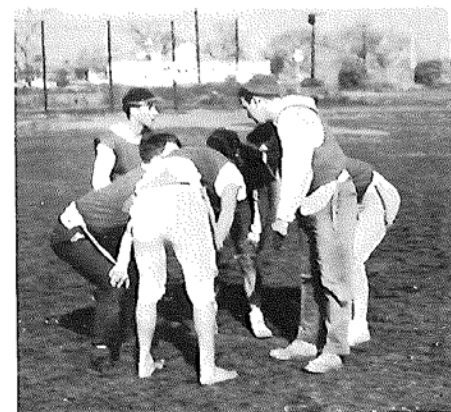
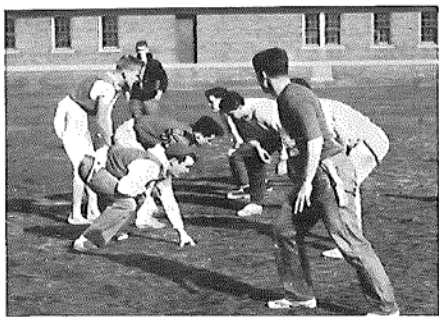




Football

Rod and Gun Club

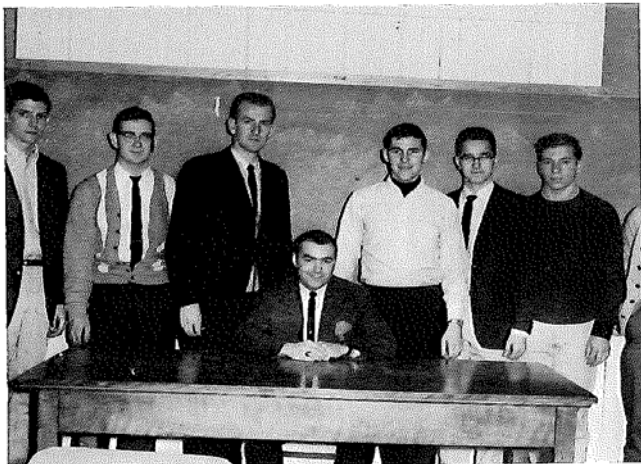
One of the newest organizations on campus this year is the Rod and Gun Club. The members are instructed in the use and handling of firearms and the real meaning of sportsmanship.

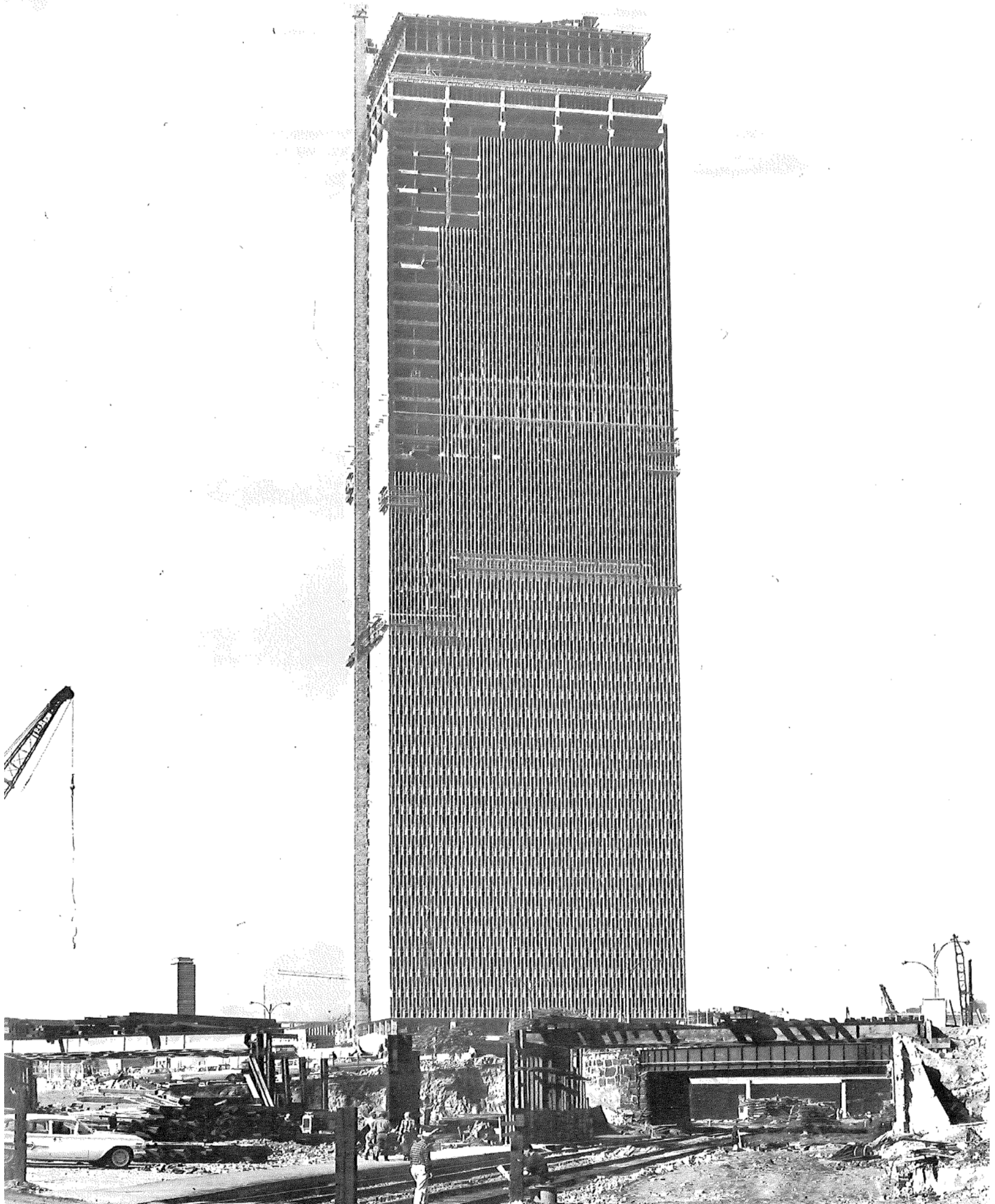


Ski Club
