III. BOARD VOTE: MASS MUTUAL CENTER RADIO INFRASTRUCTURE

John Donahue, Chief of Operations and Capital Projects, discussed upgrading the MassMutual Center's Radio Infrastructure, emphasizing the need for equipment replacement and compliance with safety standards. There was a brief discussion about how these radios will sync with the local police department and public safety departments. The current equipment is beyond its useful life and needs replacement. He presented the following vote to the Committee.

VOTED: The Development & Construction Committee of the Massachusetts Convention Center Authority recommends that the full board adopt the following vote.

VOTE: The Massachusetts Convention Center Authority hereby votes to authorize the Chief Executive Officer or his Designee to execute a contract for the Equipment and Services to Applied Communications Systems Incorporated (ACSI) to support the radio replacement and infrastructure upgrades in the amount of three hundred sixty-three thousand eight hundred eighty-two dollars and fifty-five cents (\$363,882.55) per construction plans and specifications documents dated June 5, 2025.

IV. BOARD VOTE: SECURITY SCREENING EQUIPMENT

Rob Noonan, Chief Information Officer, discussed the importance of security screening and its effectiveness during events. There was a question from the Board about how security screenings occur with back-of-house operations. Rob Noonan explained that given the volume and logistics of the dock area, etc., it's not feasible to do that type of enhanced security for every show but for specific show and VIPs enhanced security is used in those areas. He presented the following vote to the Committee members.

VOTED: The Development & Construction Committee of the Massachusetts Convention Center Authority recommends that the full board adopt the following vote

VOTE: The Massachusetts Convention Center Authority hereby authorizes the Chief Executive Officer or his Designee to enter into a contract with Evolv Technology for 4 years in an amount not to exceed \$1,189,700.
