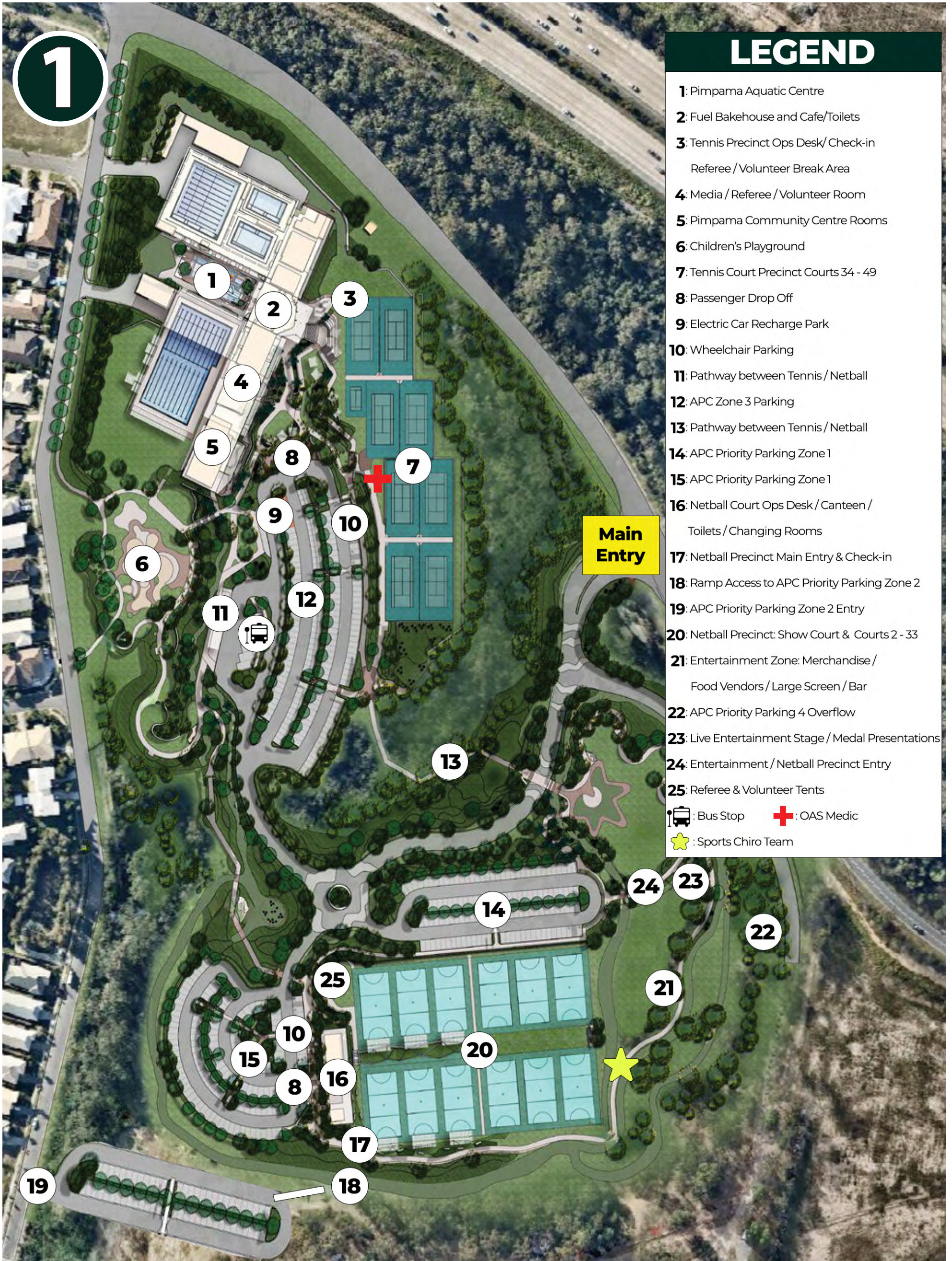

Parking

There are a 5 parking locations around the Pimpama Sports Hub Precinct; however parking will be limited and we encourage participants to ride share or take public transport. There are two drop off locations (one outside the netball precinct and one outside the Aquatic centre closest to the Tennis Precinct). As we are sharing the Parking Space with the Pimpama Aquatic Centre we request that players avoid parking in Priority Car Park 3 (Outside the Aquatic Centre) and mainly use this entrance to drop players off who are playing at the Tennis Court Precinct.

The overflow carpark located off Bull Road has a zigzag walkway down to the Netball Court precinct. We encourage players participating in morning sessions to use this carpark as it is only open during daylight hours as there is no lighting around the carpark.

There is additional off road parking to the left as you enter Pimpama Sports Hub but this is off-road and under trees so participants park here at their own risk.

If you do park on the streets above the Pimpama Sports Hub please be respectful of Residential parking and park within legal requirements.

Due to the limited parking we encourage participants to allow extra time for parking before they are due at the courts so everyone remains calm and focused with a large amount of participants walking in and around the precincts.
