### **Coaches Corner**

### The 3 Big Mistakes Killing Your Kitchen Line Game

Your dinking game is solid. You're getting to the kitchen line consistently. But the moment things heat up and you find yourself in a hands battle—everything falls apart.

#### Sound familiar?

Here's the brutal truth: if your hands aren't fast enough at the net, you're giving away free points.

The following are the three biggest mistakes that are killing your kitchen line game. And here's the thing—you're probably making at least one of them right now.

### Mistake #1: Changing Your Grip for Hands Battles

When the pace picks up, players panic and adjust their grip. Result? Balls spraying everywhere and zero control when you try to get back to dinking. Your paddle becomes a liability instead of an asset.



### Mistake #2: Taking Too Big of Swings

Think bigger swing equals more power? Wrong. Oversized swings leave you exposed and slow to react. Tanner's pro tip: imagine a ball tucked loosely under your armpit that can't fall out. If it drops, your swing is too big.



#### Mistake #3: Happy Feet When Hitting the Ball

Dancing around when you're hitting the ball feels natural, but it's actually slowing you down. The fastest players stay completely still and let their arms do the work.
