

How to Complete Online Education Required for Coaching Courses

Sport Integrity Australia (SIA) Edge Platform


This guide will walk you through the process of completing required online education courses on the Sport Integrity Australia Education Platform (SIA Edge). Follow these steps to enrol in, complete, and obtain certificates for courses that are outside our main education hub.

Step 1: Log In or Create a New Account

Navigate to the Sport Integrity Australia Education Platform (SIA Edge) at:



Log in with your existing account credentials or create a new user account if you don't have one.




Step 2: Navigate to the Course Catalogue

Once you're on the home page, click on the **Course Catalogue** button.



Step 3: Find and Select Your Course

Browse or search for the course you need to complete. Click on the course tile to view its details.



Step 4: Enrol in the Course

On the course details page, click the **Enrol** button to add the course to your training library.

Once enrolment is confirmed, scroll back to the top of the page and click **Home** from the main navigation tabs.

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


