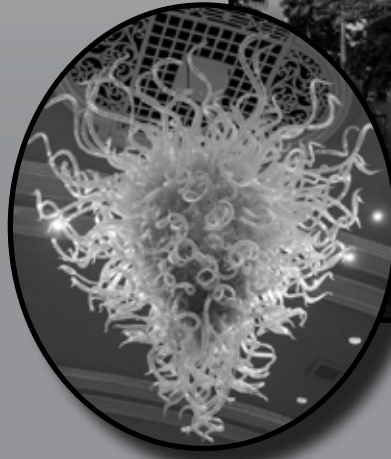

Details: We will meet at the gazebo on Main Street in Safety Harbor (just East of the Paradise Restaurant parking lot) for a 2:30 walking tour departure. There is parking in the restaurant lot, on both sides of Main Street and behind the building across Main Street from Paradise. We will have an early dinner at Paradise overlooking the gazebo.

Directions: **Directions: FROM the SOUTH** – Go North on I-275 past St. Petersburg to exit 30 for FL-686 W/Roosevelt Blvd ; go 0.7 mi ; follow signs for Florida 686 W/Roosevelt Boulevard/Largo/Clearwater and merge onto FL-686 W/Roosevelt Blvd N 1.0 mi; keep left at the fork, follow signs for Largo/Clearwater; 0.7 mi ; continue straight onto FL-688 W/Ulmerton Rd 1.2 mi ; turn right onto 49th St N/County Rd 611 (across the Bayside Bridge) 5.2 mi ; turn right onto Drew St; 0.3 mi; turn left onto N Bayshore Blvd ; go 2 mi, turn left on Main Street. Paradise will be .2 down on the right at 5th Avenue.

FROM the EAST – Go West on I-275 to exit 39 to merge onto FL-60 W/Florida 589 Toll N toward Tampa Airport/Clearwater; merge onto W Courtney Campbell Causeway for 9.7 mi; turn right onto S Bayshore Blvd 2.5 mi to the 4 way stop, turn left on Main Street. Paradise will be .2 down on the right at 5th Avenue.

FROM the NORTH – Go South on either US Hwy 19 or SR 611 (Eastlake/McMullen Booth Rd.) to Sunset Point/Main Street (Note if you are on US 19 this is an exit to the right) turn left onto Sunset Point/Main Street. From McMullen Booth it is 1.1 through Safety Harbor and Paradise Restaurant will be on the left. If you come South on either I-75 for the Suncoast Pkwy follow the signs to Tampa airport and see the directions above from the EAST

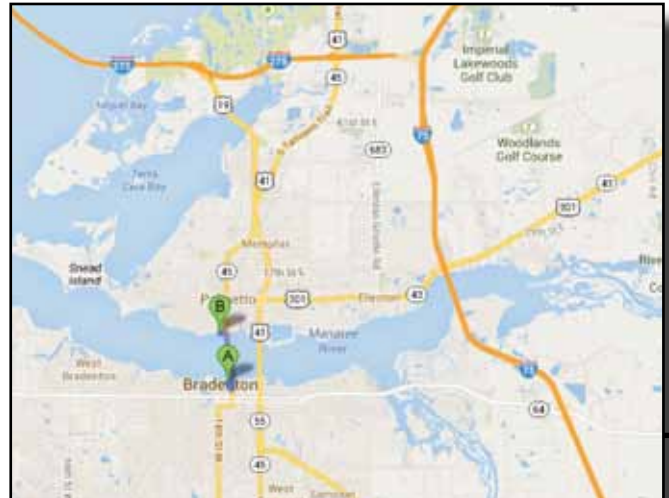
DaVinci Machine Exhibition

Important Info

Details: The DaVinci Machines Exhibition, on loan from the Museum of Leonardo DaVinci in Florence, Italy, and is one of just three such exhibits traveling the world. It contains over 60 hand-crafted inventions built from Leonardo's 500 – year old designs and is the life work of three generations of Florentine artisans. Featured machines on display include the DaVinci bicycle, hang glider, and air screw, the precursor to the modern-day helicopter. Also, on display are two of Leonardo's revolutionary robotic inventions, the life-size robot drummer and for the first time ever, the secrets behind Leonardo's legendary mechanical lion. This exhibition models are presented in four major themes: Military machines, Flying machines, Nautical & Hydraulic machines as well as devices and inventions illustrating the Principles of Mechanics. The uniquely interactive machines are a popular aspect of each exhibition as visitors can touch and handle these models to gain a first-hand appreciation of how they work. Explanatory notes and illustrative panels with Leonardo's drawings from his codices accompany each model.

We will have a docent guided tour that will be about an hour and a half. There is free parking Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays at the Bradenton Auditorium parking lot. After our tour will go 1.4 miles across the bridge to Riverhouse Reef & Grill for an early dinner (B on the map).

Directions: The map to the right is Bradenton & the museum is marked with the A in the bubble. I decided that most everyone has a GPS in the car or on their phones. So use the museum address in the Important Info box to find the way with specific directions from your home. Google maps or MapQuest also will allow you to print directions from your computer.

Vinoy Tour & Lunch

St. Petersburg, FL

October 19, 2013

In October the Mercedes Club visited the Vinoy Renaissance Hotel in St. Petersburg for a docent-led historical tour. This event generated a lot of interest, with 42 people attending.

We learned that the idea of a waterfront hotel began with a bet that famed golfer Walter Hagen could drive a golf ball off the face of the pocket watch of Aymer Vinoy Laughner, a wealthy businessman. He did and Mr. Laughner purchased the land where the ball landed to build a grand resort. The Vinoy Park Hotel was built in just 10 months and opened on New Year's Eve 1925.

Despite the fact that the "Boom Era" was ending as the Vinoy opened, it was still considered one of the country's most prestigious destinations for the world's rich and famous. The Vinoy survived the Great Depression and was known as the "grand dame" of St. Petersburg, attracting wealthy Northerners anxious to escape harsh winters.

During World War II, the Vinoy ceased operations as a hotel and became a housing and training center for military cooks and bakers. In 1944, the Vinoy re-opened as a hotel; however, the Vinoy's resistance to install air conditioning prompted people to go elsewhere and it fell out of favor. Lack of maintenance forced the hotel to close its doors in 1974.

For 18 years the Vinoy was a refuge for the homeless and SWAT teams who used it for practice. It was saved by voter referendum and a two-year reconstruction began. It re-opened in 1992 with a new guest tower, tennis complex, golf course, pools and spas, a 74-slip marina and, of course, air conditioning.

We enjoyed a delicious three course luncheon in the famous Marchands Bar and Grill after the tour.

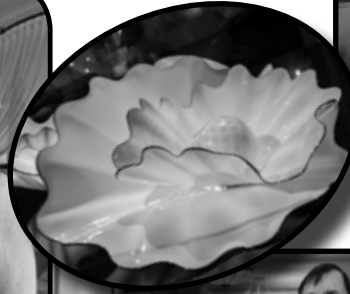
