

MERCEDES – AMG GT S New Twin-Turbo V-8 M178 Engine

The new AMG GT S, due on sale in April of this year, has a new twin turbocharged V8 engine; the M178. Displacing just 4.0 liters, the M178 engine manages a specific output of just over 126 horsepower per liter, rating 503 HP total with 479 pound-feet of torque over a wide rpm range.



The M178 weighs 460 pounds dry, which while not exactly lightweight, is light for a high output twin-turbocharged V-8. A unique feature of this engine is the placement of the twin turbos inside the valley of the V-8's layout, termed "hot inside V" by Mercedes. In order to accomplish this, Mercedes engineers essentially swapped the placement of the exhaust and intake manifolds. The turbochargers are mounted directly to the exhaust ports of the heads, while the intake runners are mounted to the outside of the heads.

To help cool the under-hood temperatures, the GT S has an air intake just above the radiator, which directs air just above the engine and exits just before the windshield.

MERCEDES-BENZ MOVING U.S. HEADQUARTERS TO ATLANTA

Daimler AG is moving down south, uprooting Mercedes-Benz USA (MBUSA) headquarters from its longtime perch in New Jersey with plans to relocate it to an Atlanta suburb. Daimler's U.S. luxury car offices have been based in New Jersey since 1972. Wooed by lower costs, proximity to a Mercedes-Benz factory, and government incentives, the German luxury carmaker in July will begin moving about 1,000 U.S. personnel to a temporary facility and later move to Sandy Springs, Georgia.

The operation, which includes staff working on the Sprinter van business and the Smart mini car lineup, will permanently move into a new building erected on a 10-acre site in the same city.
